B.O.O.T. Camp!

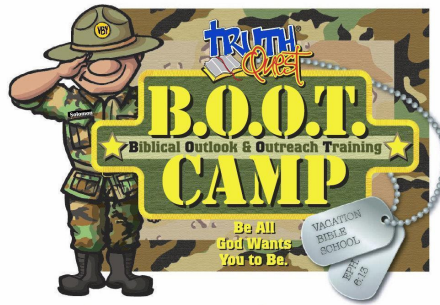
I'm so excited to announce that we will be having a Senior VBY for all those that will be entering 5th-8th grade in the fall!

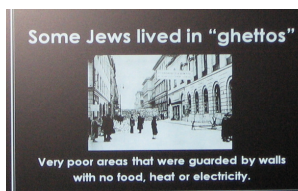

On Sunday, April 11th, we were honored to hear Rose Price talk about her experiences as a Holocaust survivor.

The following Tuesday night, all the children gathered on the stage of the MJCC for a presentation on Yom HaShoah by Stephanie. She taught them the importance of remembering what our Jewish people went through. They learned about all the many

things that Jewish children were not allowed to do because they were "just Jewish." They all squeezed in a tight small circle to demonstrate what it would have been like to live in a ghetto.



Stephanie ended with explaining to the children what it meant to honor someone.

At the end of the teaching, all of the children made cards for Rose Price, thanking her for sharing her story and showing great courage during an extremely difficult time. This was their way of honoring Rose Price.
